APPLICATION FORM

DESCRIPTION:

This scholarship is open to children of Hadassah members or who belong to Young Judea. The child must reside in Benton, Linn, Lincoln or Polk counties. The scholarship is to be used only for Hadassah or Young Judea programs. The award amount will vary according to the cost of the program and the number of scholarships previously received. For the Israeli program, a person is eligible only once. Recipients will be expected to report in person on their experiences at a regular Hadassah meeting upon their return home.

APPLICATIONS:

1. Applications should include this cover page, answers to the scholarship questions and two letters of recommendations.
2. Applications must be completed by the applicant.
3. Email applications will NOT be accepted
4. Letters of recommendation: Letters of recommendation from two people (not relatives) who are familiar with the applicant's involvement in Jewish activities. The letters need not be from local people. If siblings are applying, one letter must be from a different person.
5. Complete recommendations should be mailed to Ruth Goldberg-Selma Loney Scholarship Committee, c/o Beit Am, P.O. Box 1143, Corvallis OR 97339.
6. Applications must be postmarked by February 15, 2008.
