Young Judaea Campership Incentive Program

What is Young Judaea's Campership Incentive Program?

- Young Judaea is pleased to offer the Campership Incentive Program, which is intended to encourage families to explore the transformative benefits of Young Judaea camping
- The Young Judaea's Campership Incentive grants are not based on financial need, but rather provide a financial incentive to encourage first time campers to choose one of the six Young Judaea camps
- The Campership Program awards incentives in the amount of \$1000 per camper

Who is eligible?

- Children who wish to attend a Young Judaea camp for a session of 3-weeks or more, and who have never previously attended a Jewish residential (sleep-away) camp for two consecutive weeks or more
- Multiple children from a single family are eligible to receive separate grants and will be considered separate grantees

Who is not eligible?

- Children from communities where a similar incentive program is already in place through the Foundation for Jewish Camping in partnership with the local Federation or other locally determined sources; Children from those families are expected to apply for the incentive program that is offered in their community

Who makes this program possible?

- The program is offered by Young Judaea, with funding from Hadassah, The Women's Zionist Organization of America, in partnership with the Foundation for Jewish Camping

How do I apply?

- Contact the Young Judaea camp in your area to receive an application; If you don't know how to reach your nearest Young Judaea camp, you can find it by visiting www.youngjudaea.org or by calling 212.303.4570
- Applications will be considered on a rolling basis, typically within 30 days of receipt
