## Rabbi (full time)

The rabbi will routinely interact and cooperate with the Board and other lay leaders to further the welfare of the membership. S/he will lead our members in working for tikkun olam. Beit Am is an egalitarian, welcoming community, recognizing and celebrating the diversity of our membership.
